- 1/** A photocopy of the applicant's official final high-school transcript
- 2/** A photocopy of the applicant's acceptance letter into a post secondary institution
- 3/** A brief essay (minimum 500 words) written by the applicant describing the following:
 - The applicant's chosen program and institution of post-secondary study
 - The applicant's personal and professional goals
 - Contributions the applicant has made to his/her school, dojo and/or community over the past three years – including volunteer and work experience
 - A description of how the applicant's participation in Chito-Ryu Karate has helped prepare him/her for life after high school, overcome personal hardship, etc.
 - Any other information the applicant would like to share
- 4/** A brief letter from a teacher or an Administrator at the applicant's High School in support of the application
